When to go?

Ruaha Park can be experienced throughout the year, though the rainy season starts from late December to April and the difference is stunning.

The wet season is a prime time for bird watching in the Southern Highlands as it is the breeding season and the males are in full plumage. As well, many migrants are present at this time.

With over 350 endemic species as well as nearly 200 regular migrant species.

Date	Activity	Accommodation
Day 1	Fly to Iringa airport where you will be met by your birding expert & have breakfast in Iringa Arrive at Ruaha National Park Check In at accommodations & pickup lunch Afternoon/Evening prime birding circuit Return back to Tandala Camp	Tandala Tented Camp
Day 2	Early Breakfast (with optional birdwatching) Depart for the park with a packed lunch Take a walking safari along the river to spend time identifying different species Return to camp & enjoy the evening	Tandala Tented Camp
Day 3	Depart early for the park for prime morning time Take lunch at Ruaha River Lodge which has over 200 bird species in the campsite alone Finish with a final circuit before returning to Iringa	Zakinn Iringa
Day 4	After spending overnight at Zakinn, you will fly back to Dar es Salaam in the morning	Auric or FlightLink
