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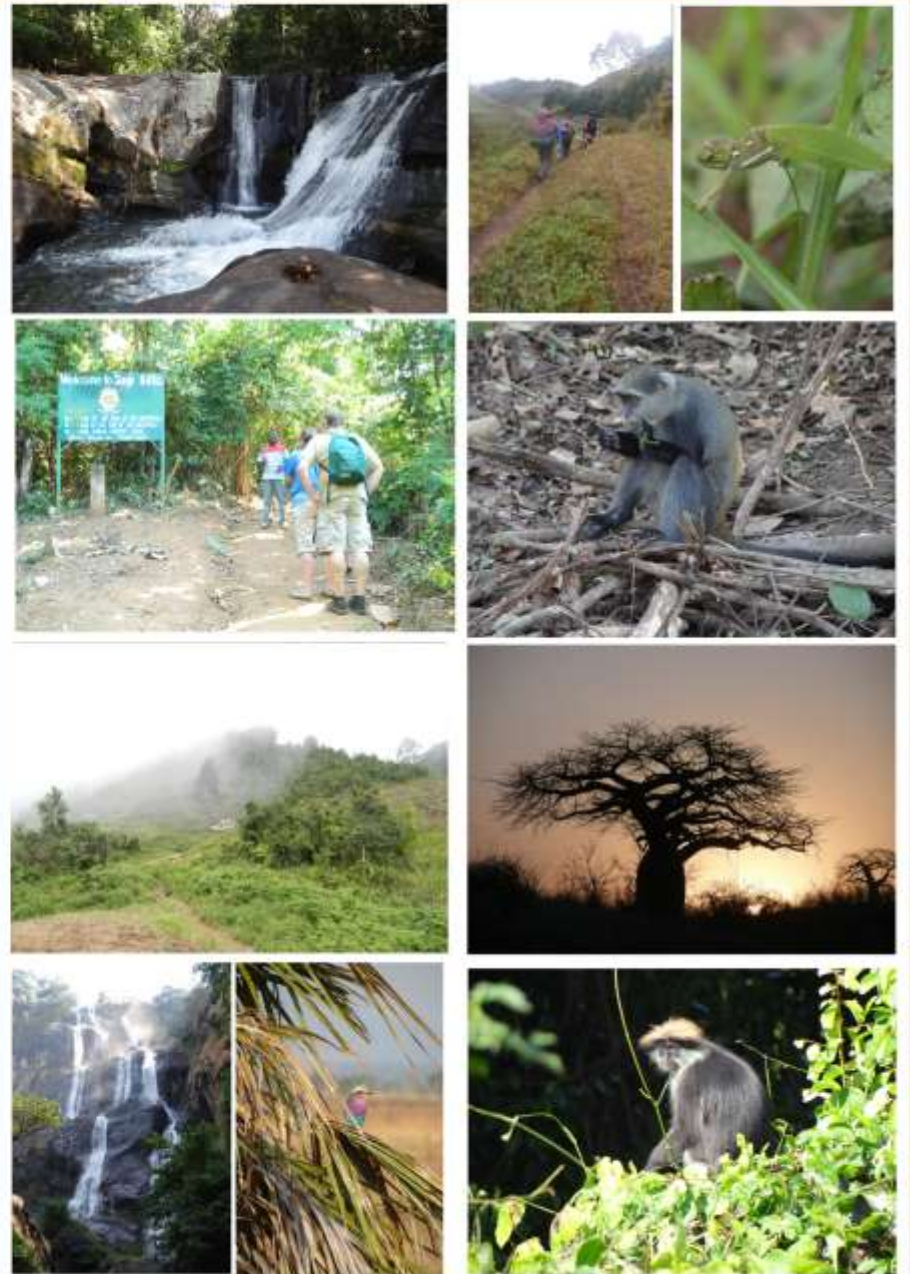
Udzungwa National Park

When to go?

This park is best visited from May to January. Hiking is the primary activity in Udzungwa with 1/2day hikes to Sanje Falls (The largest falls in the national park system. This is the only national park in Tanzania which has 11 primate species including 5 species which are found nowhere else in the world including the Sanje Mangabey, Iringa Red Colobus and the recently discovered Rungwedebus Kipunji monkey.

Also visit a local elephant conservation project which works to reduce crop raiding by using beehive fences.
